I receive several phone calls and e-mails every week from people who share with me that they cannot chew or eat raw veggies, fruit, or steak. They avoid going out to dinner with family and friends. They share with me that they avoid social activities and public speaking. They are perceived as grumpy or anti-social. They share with me that this is not who they are, but rather what they have become as a result of missing teeth and ill-fitting partials or dentures. More people are becoming aware that there is an alternative to ill-fitting partials and dentures. Today's modern dental technology with CT scans and 3D imaging software is making it

possible to offer people an alternative that can be accomplished in weeks instead of years. Dr. Djawdan is one of less than 4% of dentists in the United States who can personally handle every step of this transformation.

Dentures get in the way of life. I always learn something new when I ask why a client is seeking an alternative to removable teeth. People have shared with me that they want to be able to go into the ocean again without the fear of losing their denture, SCUBA dive, eat steak again, and kiss.

We have helped people from all over the United States from age 38 to 78 transition from hopeless teeth or already missing teeth to confident teeth that look and feel natural. This past November I received a call from a mother who shared with me that her eight-year-old daughter asked her not to come to school anymore, because of her teeth. She shared with me that she was terrified of the dentist and had hopeless teeth. We were able to give her a new smile before Christmas. Her daughter made Dr. Djawdan a thank you card and Christmas ornament to thank him for giving her mommy her smile back.
